Huntwick Monthly Crime and Traffic Stats: November 2022

There were no significant incidents this month. However, our deputies did respond to the following:

# Illegally Parked Vehicles and Traffic Stops:

lock your cars when parked on the street or in your driveway. Please keep your speed down (the limit is 30 mph) when driving through Huntwick.

**Suspicious Activity** (BLUE LIGHT), if you're walking or driving around Huntwick and notice a blue light on at Donut Lake Park or the Recreation center, you can call 713-364-8869 for details of the alert.

Harris County Sheriff's Department has rolled out a new **SAFETY CAM program**, where you can pre-register your home surveillance cameras with the Sheriff's department. If a crime happens and your camera catches it, you could provide detectives with footage.
